

Please contact the CPW Commission, the governor's office and our senator Leroy Garcia and ask them to have CPW reconsider the mountain lion killing plan between Cañon City and Leadville.

The plan will allow the slaughter of 50% of mountain lions between Cañon City and Leadville and their kittens left to starve. Scientific studies in neighboring state have shown that this strategy does not boost mule deer herds in the long-term. Human disturbances in critical winter ranges, diminished food supplies, climate change which allows the proliferation of parasites which weaken deer health, etc. are the real culprits.

Stress that birders and wildlife watchers are willing to help pay for the operation of CPW so we can have a voice in the decisions being made. Say anything else you want to say.
